On the North wall of the Bagrave chancel, inclofed with iron rails, is a tablet, with thefe arms: Quarterly; I. Azure, fretty, Argent, *Cave*; 2. and 3. Ermine, on a bend Sable, three whales heads Or, *Whalley*; in the fefs point, a cretcent Or. Creft, on a wreath, a greyhound currant Sable; motto, SOYES LOYAL.

Also the above quarterings; impaling, Or, a fefs between two chevrons Sable, Lifle; Plate XLI. fig. 2, 3. And on each fide, the cyphers "F.C." and "F.M."

"Monumentum Francisci Cabe, de Baggrave, ar. qui obut die an<sup>°</sup> 15....<sup>6</sup> et Margar' uror? suæ, quæ ob. 26 die Odob. an<sup>°</sup> 1568."
