Richard Cave of Stanford, co. Northampton, esquire (eldest son of Thomas Cave of Stanford, by Thomasine Passemere his wife); succeeded his father 17 September 1495; High Sheriff for co. Northampton 1530; died 20 April 1538, bur. at Stanford. Memorial Brass. Will dated 13 June 1536, proved 22 June 1538 (P.C.C. 18 *Dingeley*).

Margaret Saxby, sister of William Saxby of Northampton, and of Calais, merchant of the staple; died in March 153 $\frac{1}{2}$, bur. at Stanford. Memorial Brass. 2nd wife.

Sir Thomas Cave of Stanford, co. Northampton; knighted at Westminster, after the Coronation of Queen Mary, 2 October 1553; executrix to will of his brother Clement 9 March 153 $\frac{4}{5}$; died 4 September 1558, bur. at Stanford. M.L. Will dated 10 December 1556, with codicil dated 20 January 155 $\frac{6}{7}$, proved 10 September 1558 (P.C.C. 44 *Hogan*). Inq. p. m. taken at Leicester 4 October 1558 (*C. Vol. 116, No. 95*).

Elizabeth Danvers, sister and coheir of John Danvers, and dau. of John Danvers of Waterstock, co. Oxford, esquire, by Margaret his wife, dau. of William Hampton of Harwell, co. Berks; born 2 February 150 $\frac{5}{8}$; executrix to her husband's will 10 September 1558; living 28 March 1565.

Edward Cave of Newbold Revell, co. Warwick, gent; bur. at Monks Kirby, co. Warwick. Will dated 24 November 1533, proved 9 November 1534 (P.C.C. 19 *Hogan*).

Dorothy Mallory, dau. and coheir of Nicholas Mallory of Newbold Revell, esquire; marr. before 4 November 1510 (date of marriage settlements); aged 21 and more at her father's death 22 January 151 $\frac{2}{3}$; living 24 November 1533. She married 2ndly George Ashby.

Thomas Saunders of Sibbertoft, co. Northampton, esquire; died 8 March 152 $\frac{7}{8}$. Will dated 7 March 152 $\frac{7}{8}$, proved 16 May 1528 (P.C.C. 31 *Porch*). Inq. p. m. taken at Nottingham 21 October 1528 (*C. Vol. 48, No. 136*).

Margaret, executrix to her husband's will 16 May 1528; living 21 October 1528. (?) She married 2ndly Robert Chauntrell of Foxton, co. Leicester.

Sir Thomas Andrews of Charwelton, co. Northampton, knight; died 2 February 156 $\frac{3}{4}$. Will dated 26 June 1563, proved 19 May 1564, by Roger and Edward Andrews, sons (P.C.C. 16 *Stevenson*). Inq. p. m. taken at Northampton 2 October 1564 (*C. Vol. 139, No. 141*). He marr. 2ndly Mary, dau. of John Heneage of Trowse, co. Lincoln, gent, widow of Erasmus Cooper.

Catharine, marr. before 13 June 1536; died 15 August 1555. Inq. p. m. taken at Northampton 2 October 1564 (*C. Vol. 139, No. 139*). 1st wife.

Thomas Boughton of Causton, co. Warwick, esquire; died 30 April 1558. Will dated 1 May 1558, proved 22 June 1558 (P.C.C. 30 *Noodes*). Inq. p. m. taken at Warwick 6 August 1558 (*C. Vol. 128, No. 93*).

Margaret, not 18, 24 November 1533; executrix to her husband's will 22 June 1558; died 18 June 1565. Inq. p. m. taken at Rugby 18 April 1566 (*C. Vol. 143, No. 4*).

Anthony Cave of Chichely, co. Buckingham, esquire, Citizen and Draper of London; M.P. for Liverpool 1547; died 9 September 1558, bur. in Chichely Church. M.I. Will dated 31 May 1555, proved 5 December 1558 (P.C.C. 7 *Welles*). Inq. p. m. taken at Newport Pagnell 13 March 1558 (C. Vol. 120, No. 5.)

Elizabeth Lovett, dau. of Thomas Lovett of Astwell, co. Oxford, by Ann his wife, dau. of Sir John Danvers of Dauntsey, co. Wilts, knight; died 20 August, bur. at Chichely 21 August 1577. Will dated 24 July 1577, proved 20 November 1577 (P.C.C. 44 *Daughtrey*). Inq. p. m. taken at Newport Pagnell 18 December 1577 (C. Vol. 180, No. 2). She marr. 2ndly, John Newdegate of Harefield, co. Middlesex, esquire (see Vol. 7, page 34); and 3rdly Richard Weston, Judge of the Common Pleas.

Will dated 27 December 1603, with codicil dated 31 March 1608, proved 3 June 1608, by William Chester, son (P.C.C. 57 *Windebank*). He marr. 2ndly Ann, dau. of Robert Freere.

Judith, born 15 November 1542; bur. at St. Dionis, Backchurch, London, 6 July 1570.

Griffith Hampden of Great Hampden, co. Buckingham, esquire; Sheriff for co. Buckingham 1575; M.P. for Buckingham 1585; died 27 October, bur. at Great Hampden 18 November 1591. Will dated 15 July 1589 and 27 August 1591, proved 29 April 1592 (P.C.C. 29 *Harrington*).

Anne, born 24 February 1544; executrix to her husband's will 29 April 1592; died 31 December 1593, bur. at Great Hampden 9 January 1594.

Richard Cave of Little Oakley, co. Northampton, esquire; aged 30 and more 4 September 1558; died 3 April 1560. Inq. p. m. taken at Northampton 1 October 1561 (C. Vol. 113, No. 153).

Elizabeth Montague, dau. of Sir Edward Montague, knight, Chief Justice of the Common Pleas, by Eleanor his 3rd wife, dau. of Sir John Roper; marriage settlements dated 18 January 1552, marr. before 1 June 1552; died 26 January 1567. Inq. p. m. taken at Northampton 2 September 1568 (C. Vol. 148, No. 53). She marr. 2ndly William Markham of Great Oakley, co. Northampton.

Edward Gates of Seamer, co. York, esquire. Elizabeth, born 30 August 1558; marr. before 17 July 1572.

Anne Cave, born 3 November 1560; died 5 July 1565. Inq. p. m. taken at Northampton 17 July 1572 (C. Vol. 161, No. 124).

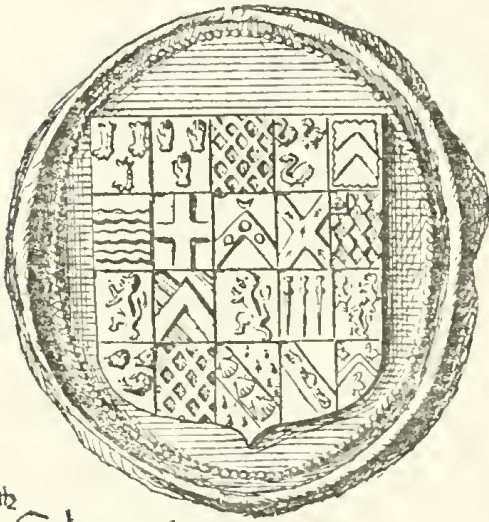
Roger Cave of Stanford, co. Northampton, esquire; not 24, 10 December 1556; executor to his father's will 10 September 1558; died 26 July 1586, (?) bur. at St. Martin's, Stamford, co. Northampton. Will dated 17 April 1586, proved 2 September 1586 (P.C.C. 45 *Windsor*). Inq. p. m. taken at Daventry 15 August 1587 (C. Vol. 213, No. 148.)

Margaret Cecil, dau. of Richard Cecil of Burghley, co. Northampton, by Jane his wife, dau. and heir of William Heckington of Bourne, co. Lincoln, esquire (sister of Lord Treasurer Burghley); marr. at St. Clement Danes', London, 24 November 1561; living 1 March 1597 (will of Lord Burghley); died before 30 September 1599. She marr. 2ndly Erasmus Smith, son of John Smith of Withcock, co. Leicester, esquire, by Dorothy Cave his wife (see page 127).

Warwick, esquire; executrix to Will dated 25 November 1534, proved at Lambeth her husband's will 9 March 1534⁴.

John Newdegate of Harefield, co. Middlesex, and of Arbury, co. Warwick, esquire; born at Beaconsfield, co. Buckingham, in 1541; educated at Eton and at King's College, Cambridge, Scholar 25 August 1559, Fellow 26 August 1562, B.A. 1563³, M.A. of the University of Prague; aged 23, 2 February 1565⁸; admitted to Lincoln's Inn 23 January 1556⁶; administrator to his father 4 July 1566; exchanged his lands at Harefield, co. Middlesex (except Brackenbury) for Arbury with Sir Edmund Anderson, Chief Justice; died in the Fleet Prison 22 February, bur. at St. Mildred's-in-the-Poultry, London, 26 February 1591¹. Inq. p. m. taken at the Castle in St. John Street Without Bars, London, 19 May 1592 (C. Vol. 232, No. 58).
Martha, born 24 February 1545⁵; marriage settlements dated 20 March 1563³; died 22 November 1575, bur. at Harefield. Inq. p. m. taken at Colnebrook 29 May 1592 (C. Vol. 232, No. 15). *Portrait at Arbury in the possession of Francis Alexander Newdigate-Newdegate. 1st wife.*

Henry Knollys (son and heir apparent of Sir Francis Knollys, K.G.); executor to his father-in-law's will 18 March 157 $\frac{1}{2}$; bur. at Stanford. M.I.

Margaret, born 25 April 1549; marr. before 9 May 1566 (date of marriage settlements); died 15 August 1600.

Sir Jerome Weston of Roxwell, co. Essex, knight (eldest son and heir of Richard Weston, Judge of the Common Pleas, by Wiburga his 1st wife, dau. of Michael Catesby of Scaton, co. Rutland, esquire); succeeded his father 6 July 1572, then aged 22; Sheriff of co. Essex 1599; knighted at the Charterhouse 11 May 1603; died 31 December 1603, bur. at Roxwell 17 January 160 $\frac{3}{4}$. Will dated 28 December 1603, proved 21 November 1604 (P.C.C. 84 *Harte*). Inq. p. m. taken at Dunmow 30 August 1604 (*C. Vol. 286, No. 167*). He marr. 2ndly Margery, dau. of George Pert, Citizen of London.
