Sep. 27, 1543. Richarde Foxcrofte,42 of Sourbie, within the parishe of Hallifax, sole and unmaried. To be buried in the churche yerde at Hallifax. Also I will that all the dettes which I owe unto my bretherne and susters concernynge ther childe partes, and euery parte and porcon therof, and to euery other person, or personnes, be well, trulie, and hollie content and paide by my executors, with suche goodes and dettes as I have gyven and delyuered unto theme befor the day of the date herof with myne owne handes, and also with suche other goodes and dettes as I have and as is owinge unto me at this present day. bequeathe to the reparacon and mendinge of Sorebie bridge xs. To Margaret Whitacres, Johane Walker, Margaret Benteley, Henrie Benteley, and William Wode, to euery one of theme, xxs. sterlinge. The reuercon of all my goodes, my dettes paide as funerall expenses as besemeth, I bequeathe to James Foxcrofte, Georgie Foxcrofte, and to John Foxcrofte, my bretherne, equally, whome I ordan my executors. Thes witnesses, John Brige, James Robynson, John Mawde, and James Dobson of Stones.
