

Will of Mark Hopwood 1682 (Borthwick Institute)

Summary

Testator: Mark Hopwood, of Micklefield
Executors: wife Margaret
Date: 4 May 1681, proved 2 December 1682
Witnesses: Thomas Simpson, John Baine
Will:
- 1s to eldest son Francis and his wife Grissell
- £7 to son Robert and 10s to his wife Elizabeth
- £7 to son Richard and 10s to his wife Katherine
- rest to wife Margaret for life, then to son William, they paying
- £1 to Samuel son of son William
- 20s to Mary daughter of son William
- 10s to Elizabeth wife of son William

Text

In the name of God amen

1. On the fourth day of May in the year of our Lord 1681 I Mark Hopwood of Micklefield within the county of York being weak in body but of perfect mind and memory praised be God do make my last Will and Testament in manner and form following
2. Imprimus I give and bequeath my soul to God my creator trusting to be saved through the merits of Jesus Christ my mediator or redeemer and my body to be buried at the discretion of my executrix
3. Item I give to my eldest son Francis Hopwood & to Grissell his wife either of them a shilling in full their child's portion
4. Item I give to my son Robert Hopwood seven pounds to be paid at two several times or days of payment that is to say one moiety thereof at the end of twelve months after my decease & the other moiety at the end of twelve months after that & ten shillings to Elizabeth his wife
5. Item I give to my son Richard Hopwood seven pounds to be paid at the said times or days of payment & ten shillings to Katherine his wife
6. Item I give all the residue or remainder of my goods and chattels movable & unmovable to Margaret my wife whom I constitute and make sole executrix of this my last Will & testament for & during the term of her natural life & after her decease to my son William Hopwood they giving to Samuel his son twenty shillings & to Mary his daughter ten shillings & to Elizabeth the wife of my son William ten shillings & discharging the above said legacies & my funeral expenses out of the same
7. In Witness whereof I have hereunto set my hand & seal the 12th day of December 1681
