Text

1. This is the last Will and Testament of me Judith Hudson of Morgan Street in the parish of Saint George in the county of Middlesex Widow
2. I desire to be buried in the same grave with my late husband in Hackney Church Yard and that Robert Edward Turner of No 27 Eldon Street undertaker be employed on the occasion
3. I give to my niece Catherine Sadler of Gloucester Street near Cambridge Heath Tollgate my gold watch
4. I direct that all other my personal estate or such part thereof as shall not consist of money be sold and disposed of I give and bequeath the following legacies namely
5. To my sister Mary Pritchard if living at the time of my decease the sum of ten pounds
6. To Anna Maria Turner late of Eldon Street aforesaid widow the sum of five pounds
7. To Mr William Barnes of No 11 Church Street Spitalfields five pounds
8. And Mrs Letitia Maria Wheatstone of 31 Tonbridge Street Kings Cross Saint Pancras the sum of ten pounds
9. And as to all my freehold messuages or tenements hereditaments and premises situate in Morgan Street aforesaid or elsewhere and all the rest residue and remainder of my personal estate I give devise and bequeath unto my nephew Thomas Higgs Hudson his heirs executors administrators and assigns
10. Nevertheless I do hereby charge and make subject my real estate with payment of all legacies given by this my will in case my personal estate after payment of my just debts and funeral and testamentary expenses shall be insufficient to pay the same
11. and I appoint the said Thomas Higgs Hudson my sole executor of this my last will and testament hereby revoking all former and other wills and testamentary dispositions by me heretofore made
12. In Witness whereof I have hereunto set my hand & seal this sixth day of April in the year of our Lord one thousand eight hundred and forty one
