- 1. I <u>Daniel Mills of the parish of St. Nicholas Deptford in the county of Kent hatter</u> being in good health of body and of sound and disposing mind, memory and understanding (praised be God for the same) do make publish and declare this to be my last Will and Testament in manner and order following (that is to say)
- 2. First and principally I commend my soul into the hands of almighty God and my body I commit to the earth to be decently interred at the discretion of my executrix hereinafter named and as for and concerning such worldly estate as I may happen to die possessed of I give and dispose thereof as follows (that is to say)
- 3. First I subject all my estate and effects to the payment of all my just debts funeral expenses and the charge of proving this my last Will
- 4. And so subject I give and bequeath <u>all</u> such goods chattels ready money debts estate and effects as I am possessed of interested in or entitled unto at the time of my decease and all securities relating to the same unto my <u>loving wife Mary Mills</u> her executors administrators and assigns for ever
- 5. And I do hereby make constitute and appoint her my said dear wife Mary Mills sole executrix of this my last Will and Testament
- 6. And I do hereby revoke and make absolutely void all former and other Wills by me at any time heretofore made and do declare these presents and none other to be and contain my whole and only last Will and Testament
- 7. In Witness whereof I the said Daniel Mills have hereunto set my hand and seal this tenth day of April in the thirty third year of the reign of our sovereign Lord George the second by the grace of God of Great Britain France and Ireland King Defender of the Faith etc. and in the year of our Lord one thousand seven hundred and sixty
