I <u>Isaac Mills of the parish of St. Nicholas Deptford in the County of Kent Felt Maker</u> being of a sound disposing mind memory and understanding blessed be God therefore do this twenty third of February in the year of our Lord one thousand eight hundred and four make publish and declare this my last Will and Testament in manner and form following that is to say
- 2. Imprimus I commend my soul into the hands of Almighty God who gave it me and my body to the earth from whence it ... in hope of a joyful resurrection through the Merit of my Saviour Jesus Christ and for that worldly estate wherewith it hath pleased God to bless me with I dispose thereof as follows
- 3. I give and bequeath to my <u>sister Jane Wallis the sum of one hundred pounds</u> in the three percent Consolidated Annuities
- 4. And I likewise give to my niece Mary Catford the sum of five pounds
- 5. and I give to my <u>niece Jane Outhdy?? the sum of ten pounds</u>
- 6. And I give to my <u>niece Elizabeth Roisu?? the sum of five pounds</u>

## 7. and I give to my niece Esther Mills the sum of ten pounds

- 8. And I give to my niece Mary Carter wife of George Carter the sum of five pounds
- 9. and I give to my <u>nephew David Lormier the sum of ten pounds</u>
- 10. and I give to my niece Jane Lormier the sum of five pounds
- 11. and I give to my niece Esther Lormier the sum of five pounds

- 12. and I give and bequeath unto my <u>niece Mary Elizabeth Carter who now lives with me</u> after my just debts are paid and my ? funeral expenses and what I have bequeathed above all the <u>remainder</u> part of my goods chattels and personal estate whatever money that is or may be in the Stocks and all my Stocks in Trade Book Debts Money or Moneys I have or may have ? or belonging to be at the time of my decease and I give to my niece Mary Elizabeth Carter all my household goods plate china linen wearing apparel
- 13. And I do hereby constitute and appoint my <u>niece Mary Elizabeth Carter Executrix</u> and my <u>nephew George Carter her brother to be Executor</u> of this my last Will and Testament
- 14. and I do bequeath unto my <u>nephew George Carter the sum of five pounds</u>
- 15. and I hereby revoking and making void all other and former wills heretofore made and I do declare this to be my last Will and Testament
- 16. In Witness whereof I have hereunto set my hand and seal the day and year above witness

On which day appeared personally Mary Elizabeth Carter of the parish of St. Nicholas Deptford in the County of Kent Spinster and by virtue of her Corporal Oath deposed that she is the niece and one of the Executors named in the last Will and Testament of Isaac Mills late of he parish of St. Nicholas Deptford aforesaid deceased who departed this life on the 29th of March last and this deponent says that Esther Mills Spinster who was also the niece of the deceased departed this life in the month of March 1805 and that shortly after such her death he the said deceased did in this deponent's presence obliterate the legacy of ten pounds which he had in his will bequeathed to the said Esther Mills in the thirteenth line of his said will now hereunto annexed in manner as thereon now appears M. E. Carter

Same day the said Mary Elizabeth Carter Spinster was duly sworn to the truth of this affidavit before me C. Coote Surr. ? Geo. Bogg Not. Publ.

This Will was proved at London the tenth day of April in the year of our Lord one thousand eight hundred and six before the worshipful Charles Coote Doctor of Laws and Surrogate of the Right Honourable Sir William Wynne Knight Doctor of Laws Master ? and Commissary of the Prerogate Court of Canterbury lawfully constituted by the oath of Mary Elizabeth Carter Spinster the niece and George Carter the nephew of the deceased the Executors named in the said Will to whom administration was granted of all and singular the goods chattels and credits of the said deceased their being both first sworn duly to administer.
