In the name of God amen

- 1. Anno Domini one thousand six hundred and fifteen and the seventeenth day of September in the year of the reign of our sovereign Lord James by the grace of God of England France and Ireland King Defender of the Faith the thirteenth and of Scotland the nine and fortieth
- 2. I <u>Henry Palavicine of Badburgham in the County of Cambridge and Diocese of Ely knight</u> in perfect memory God be praised make this my last Will and Testament as followeth
- 3. First I bequeath my soul into the hands of my maker saviour and redeemer and my body to be buried in the church of Badburgham
- 4. Item I give unto the poor people of Badburgham to be distributed unto them by my executor hereunder named at the day of my burial twenty pounds
- 5. Item I will devise give and bequeath unto my only and well-beloved brother Toby Palavicine equire all my goods and chattels movable and un-moveable real and personal whatsoever whereof I am possessed or any ways to me of right due payable or belonging to his own use forever in such sort and manner as if here in this my last Will and Testament they have been by me particularly specified and expressed to the intent he shall pay my debts and discharge my funerals
- 6. except nevertheless and always reserved unto my <u>well beloved wife her jewels and</u> wearing apparel And except also one hundred pounds of money which I will devise and appoint my executor hereunder named to bestow in one jewel by him to be given as my gift to my said beloved wife in remembrance of me her husband
- 7. And to the end also that I would have my debts paid my legacies performed and my funeral discharged carefully and faithfully I make constitute and ordain my said <u>loving</u> brother Toby Palavicine my sole executor of this my last Will and Testament
- 8. In witness whereof I have hereunto set my hand and seal these being witnesses <u>Henry Palavicine Elizabeth Palavicine Thomas Parkynson vicar de Babraham Thomas Bannock John Adams</u>
