*1 In 2003 I recorded Sarah's baptism in 1817 from the IGI with father Samuel, but FamilySearch's user-contributed subset transcript of the IGI in 2023 has her father as William. Her death certificate in 1871 shows that she was definitely the daughter of **Samuel** and aged 45. I did not record Joseph 1811 and William 1813 in 2003 (possibly too narrow a search), but in 2023 there is Joseph 1811 son of Samuel, and William 1813 son of William. I assume that William was also a son of Samuel - he fits perfectly into the series, and we have DNA matches to his descendants.

This also seems to support the idea that this William Percy is the son of Samuel born in Carmmoney, Antrim in 1813.
