1. This is the last Will and Testament of me William Prout of Barnstaple in the County of Devon, Cooper

- 2. First I give devise and bequeath unto my dear wife Jane Prout and her assigns all that my dwelling-house and garden situate at or near a place called Hardaway Head within the parish of Barnstaple aforesaid now in the several occupations of myself Nathaniel Blackwell and Philip Gilbert To hold the same with the appurtenances thereto belonging unto my said wife and her assigns for and during the term of her natural life she and they keeping the same in tenantable repair and from
- 3. and after the decease of my said wife I give devise and bequeath the said dwelling house garden and remises unto my two daughters Susannah the wife of Thomas Bevan and Elizabeth Skinner widow to hold the same unto my said two daughters Susannah Bevan and Elizabeth Skinner their heirs and assigns for ever as tenants in common and not as joint tenants
- 4. Also I give and bequeath unto my said <u>wife the sum of thirty pounds</u> to be paid her by my executor and executrixes hereinafter named written one calendar month next after my decease
- 5. Also I give unto my said wife during her life the use of one article of a sort of my Household Goods and Furniture of her own choice and after her decease such articles of my said Household goods and Furniture as she shall so make choice of shall sink into the Residue of my Effects
- 6. All the <u>rest</u> and residue of my personal and testamentary estate and effects whatsoever (subject to the payment of my just debts legacy and funeral expences) I give and bequeath unto my son <u>William Prout and my said daughters Susannah Bevan and Elizabeth Skinner</u> equally between them share and share alike
- 7. and I hereby appoint the said <u>William Prout Susannah Bevan and Elizabeth Skinner Executor and Executrix</u> jointly of this my last will and testament hereby revoking all former Wills by me made
- 8. In Witness whereof I the said William Prout the Testator have hereunto set my Hand and Seal this sixth day of May in the year of our Lord One thousand eight hundred and fifteen
