In the name of God amen

- 1. I <u>Edward Sedgwick of Walkington in the County of Yorke Clerk</u> being in perfect health and of a sound and disposing mind memory and understanding (praised be God for the same) do make and ordain this my last Will and Testament in manner and form following (that is to say)
- 2. I give devise and bequeath unto my daughter Rebecca Sedgwick all and singular my goods and chattels and ready money and personal estate whatsoever to hold the same to her the said Rebecca Sedgwick her executors administrators and assigns forever
- 3. And I do hereby make and appoint my said daughter Rebecca Sedgwick sole executrix of this my last Will and Testament hereby revoking and disannulling all former and other Wills by me at any time heretofore made or executed
- 4. In witness whereof I the said Edward Sedgwick have to this my last Will and Testament set my hand and seal this twenty ninth day of September in the second year of the reign of our sovereign Lord George the second and in the year of our Lord one thousand seven hundred and twenty eight Edward Sedgwick signed sealed published and declared by the said Edward Sedgwick to be his last Will and Testament in the presence of we who subscribed our names? as in the presence and at the request of the testator Thomas Leake John Roan?
