- 3. And I do hereby make and appoint my said aunt Rebecca Sedgwick sole executrix of this my last Will and Testament hereby revoking and disannulling all former and other wills by me at any time heretofore made or executed
- 4. In witness whereof I the said Susannah Sedgwick have to this my last Will and Testament set my hand and seal this seventeenth of October in the year of our Lord one thousand seven hundred and thirty four
