Text

1. In the Name of God Amen the fifth day of June in the year of our Lord one thousand seven hundred & one I Thomas Steyt of Chipping Norton in the County of Oxon Taylor being in health body & of sound & perfect memory (praised be God for the same) yet considering the frailty of mans life & the uncertainty of the time of his death do make & ordain this my last Will & Testament in maner following (that is to say)
2. Imprimis I comitt my Soul to God my Creator hoping to be saved through the merritts & mediacon of my Saviour Jesus Christ and my body to the Earth from whence it came & to be decently buried at the discretion of my Executrix herein after named
3. Item all and singular my Goods Chattles & real & personall Estate whatsoever I do give devise & bequeath unto my loving wife Elizabeth Steyt
4. And I do make and appoint my said wife Elizabeth whole & sole Executrix of this my last Will and Testament
5. In Witness whereof I the said Thomas Steyt the Testator have hereunto sett my hand & seale the day & year first above written
