- In the Name of God Amen I John Turner of Burford in the County of Oxford, Joiner, 1. being at this time in a tolerable state of health and praised be God of sound mind and memory do make this my last Will and Testament as follows
- 2. First I commend my soul into the hands of my Creator hoping through the merits of my blessed saviour for eternal life and as for my worldly goods and estate I dispose of as follows
- 3. Imprimis I will that all my just debts be paid
- 4. Also I give and devise to my daughter Sarah Stait the wife of Thomas Stait all those three messuages and stables thereto belonging with appurtenances situate and being in Great St. Mary le Bone Street in the County of Middlesex and now in the possession of Giney Lamb and Tansey to hold to her for life and after her decease I give and devise the same to my Grand Daughter Sarah Stait during my term and interest therein also I give and devise my House in Burford now in the possession of Mr. Burrell with the Appurtenances to my daughter Sarah Stait for her life and after decease I give and devise the same to my Grand Daughter Sarah Stait and her Heirs for ever
- Lastly all the Rest and Residue of my Personal Estate I give to my daughter Sarah Stait whom I constitute and appoint to be Executrix of this my will
- In Witness whereof I have hereunto set my hand and seal this twenty fourth day of 6. October in the year of our Lord one thousand eight hundred and one
